## A BILL

To ban the importation of large capacity ammunition feeding devices, and to extend the ban on transferring such devices to those that were manufactured before the ban became law.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. BAN ON IMPORTING LARGE CAPACITY AMMU-**  
 2 **NITION FEEDING DEVICES.**

3 Section 922(w) of title 18, United States Code, is  
 4 amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “(1) Except as  
 6 provided in paragraph (2)” and inserting “(1)(A)  
 7 Except as provided in subparagraph (B)”;

8 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “(2) Para-  
 9 graph (1)” and inserting “(B) Subparagraph (A)”;

10 (3) by inserting before paragraph (3) the fol-  
 11 lowing:

12 “(2) It shall be unlawful for any person to import  
 13 a large capacity ammunition feeding device.”; and

14 (4) in paragraph (4)—

15 (A) by striking “(1)” each place it appears  
 16 and inserting “(1)(A)”;

17 (B) by striking “(2)” and inserting  
 18 “(1)(B)”.

19 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF BAN ON TRANSFERRING LARGE CA-**  
 20 **PACITY AMMUNITION FEEDING DEVICES TO**  
 21 **THOSE THAT WERE MANUFACTURED BEFORE**  
 22 **THE BAN BECAME LAW.**

23 (a) **ELIMINATION OF EXEMPTION FOR TRANSFER OF**  
 24 **DEVICES LAWFULLY POSSESSED BEFORE ENACTMENT**  
 25 **OF THE BAN.**—Section 922(w)(1)(B) of title 18, United

1 States Code, as so redesignated by section 1 of this Act,  
2 is amended by striking “or transfer”.

3 (b) EXPANDED DEFINITION.—Section 921(a)(31)(A)  
4 of such title is amended by striking “manufactured after  
5 the date of enactment of the Violent Crime Control and  
6 Law Enforcement Act of 1994”.
